Bumi Resources Minerals implements Health, Safety, Environmental Measure in its gold project due to the recent earthquake in Palu, Central Sulawesi

Bumi Resources Minerals mengimplementasikan tindakan Keselamatan, Kesehatan Kerja, dan Lingkungan (K3L) di tambang emasnya untuk mengantisipasi gempa bumi di Palu, Sulawesi Tengah

Jakarta, 2 October 2018

PT Bumi Resources Minerals Tbk (“BRMS” or “The Company”) today reported that its subsidiary, PT Citra Palu Minerals (“CPM”) has implemented the necessary Health, Safety, and Environmental Measures in dealing with the recent earthquake in Palu, Central Sulawesi.

CPM’s head office which is located in the downtown area within the city of Palu suffered such damages as fractured floors and walls, collapsed ceiling and outside fences. CPM’s base-camp, near the Palu’s Airport (Mutiara SIS Al-Jufri Airport), which is located some 3 km away from the CPM’s head office, also suffered physical damage as a result of the earthquake.

Despite the damages experienced by the CPM’s Head-Office and Base-Camp, BRMS reported that all of the 46 employees in the Palu’s Head Office, Base Camp, and in the Poboya River Reef’s gold site project are safe. Two employees suffered ankle injuries and one of them has been treated at the Anutapura Hospital in Palu.

PT Bumi Resources Minerals Tbk (“BRMS” atau “Perusahaan”) hari ini melaporkan bahwa anak perusahaannya, PT Citra Palu Minerals (“CPM”) telah mengimplementasikan tindakan K3L dalam usaha penanggulangan gempa bumi di Palu, Sulawesi Tengah.

Kantor pusat CPM di tengah Kota Palu mengalami berbagai kerusakan, seperti keretakan pada lantai dan dinding, dan runtuhnya atap, plafond, dan pagar tembok luar. Tempat tinggal (Mess) karyawan di dekat bandara udara Palu (Bandara Udara Mutiara SIS Al-Jufri) yang lokasinya sekitar 3 km dari kantor pusat CPM juga mengalami kerusakan fisik sebagai akibat dari gempa bumi tersebut.

Terlepas dari kerusakan yang dialami di kantor pusat CPM dan di tempat tinggal (Mess) karyawan CPM, Perusahaan melaporkan bahwa seluruh 46 karyawan di kantor pusat Palu, di tempat tinggal karyawan di Palu, dan di lokasi tambang emas di Poboya River Reef, semua dalam keadaan selamat. Dua karyawan mengalami cedera pada pergelangan kaki, yang mana satu diantaranya telah dirawat di Rumah Sakit Anutapura di kota Palu.

The Company has set up tents in the area of the Head Office for temporary shelter and to accommodate medical supplies, food and beverages, and other logistics. So far, the Company's other subsidiary, PT Gorontalo Minerals (Gorontalo, Sulawesi) has been supplying such logistic supports as the required fuel, food & beverage, clothes, medical supplies via on land transportation.

BRMS also reported that all activities in the Poboya River Reef mine site, which include topographical survey for processing plant construction, geotechnical survey for civil works, and road construction survey, have been temporarily stopped until the condition within the site stabilizes and improves.

Perusahaan juga telah mendirikan beberapa tenda di lokasi kantor pusat untuk tempat perlindungan sementara, penampungan pasokan makanan & minuman, peralatan medis, dan pasokan logistik lainnya. Sejauh ini, anak usaha dari BRMS lainnya, yaitu PT Gorontalo Minerals (Gorontalo, Sulawesi) juga telah memberi dukungan logistik terhadap CPM dalam pengiriman bahan bakar minyak, kebutuhan sandang & pangan, dan pasokan medis melalui transportasi darat.

BRMS juga melaporkan bahwa seluruh aktivitas di lokasi tambang Poboya River Reef yang mencakup Survei Topografi untuk konstruksi fasilitas pengolahan, survei geoteknik untuk pekerjaan sipil, dan survei pembangunan jalan, untuk sementara waktu telah dihentikan sampai keadaan dan kondisi di lokasi terkait kembali stabil dan membaik.
